# The Girls' Brigade Australia Inc CODE OF CONDUCT (for GIRLS)

### **DEFINITION**

"Girls" refers to all those members who are: Cadets, Juniors, Seniors, Pioneers.

### INTRODUCTION

The Girls' Brigade is a uniformed Christian Children's and Youth Organisation for girls from 5 to 21 years of age which is International and Interdenominational.

A Girls' Brigade Company must be affiliated with a recognised local Christian Church, Mission or Fellowship.

The Girls' Brigade has specific Principles, Aim, Motto and Vision, which are set out below.

### **PRINCIPLES**

The Brigade acknowledges Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord according to the Scriptures and seeks to fulfil its Aim to the glory of one God – Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

The Brigade witnesses to the standard set by Jesus Christ for the whole of life.

The Brigade promotes a just society where all people are equally valued.

### **AIM**

To help girls to become followers of the Lord Jesus Christ and through selfcontrol, reverence and a sense of responsibility to find true enrichment of life.

### **MOTTO**

Seek, serve and follow Christ.

### **VISION**

Girls' lives transformed; God's world enriched

### **GIRLS' ENTITLEMENTS**

Girls are entitled to:

- a stimulating, interesting programme;
- healthy, positive relationships with LEADERS;
- fair and just treatment, to be treated with respect;
- a safe environment;
- freedom from any risk of abuse, exploitation or manipulation.



### **GIRLS' RESPONSIBILITES**

### Girls are to:

- be aware of and agree to follow the rules of their Company;
- obey and respect the LEADERS' directions;
- show concern and a mutual respect for fellow members;
- participate, to the best of their ability, in activities provided by the Company, Division or State;
- seek to reach a high standard of speech, behaviour and actions as is befitting to a Christian organisation;

In the event a girl requires disciplinary action, the following may occur:

- (a) A LEADER may need to seek the help of the Captain/or other suitable person to resolve the problem.
- (b) The Captain may decide to contact the Parents or Guardian to discuss suitable options available as a disciplinary measure.

These options may involve:

- an apology being offered to wronged parties
- restitution of damaged property
- agreement to refrain from offensive behaviour
- exclusion of girl from certain activities or suspension of membership for a set period.
- termination of membership in cases of extreme misconduct.
- (c) Should it be necessary that the Police or other authorities be contacted such contact will be made with the knowledge of the girl/s and her parents/guardians, provided the girl is under 18 years of age.

AIM:

Each girl in The Girls' Brigade has Basic Responsibilities and Entitlements:

### **Basic Responsibilities**

- To strive to understand and live out the Motto
- To show concern and respect for follow members
- To obey and respect Leaders' directions and obey the rules of her Company

### **Basic Entitlements**

- To be treated with respect and fairness
- To meet in a safe environment
- To participate in a stimulating and interesting programme

### At Girls' Brigade I will:

- Respect the rights, feelings and safety of others by behaving myself in a responsible and courteous manner.
- Follow the instructions of Leaders and others in positions of authority.
- Participate to the best of my ability in all Girls' Brigade activities.
- Seek to reach a high standard of speech, behaviour and actions as is befitting to a Christian organisation.
